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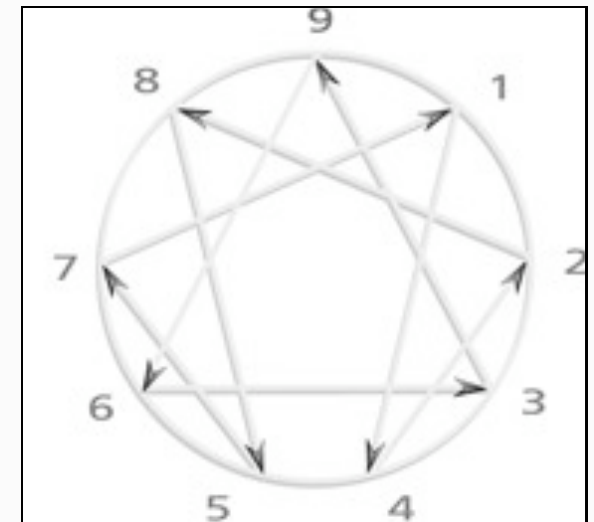

As the cofounder of Holy Ground, a 15 year-old retreat ministry in Asheville NC, she created and has led beginning and advanced Enneagram classes, pairing the Enneagram with the spiritual journey. She facilitates type and study groups, and offers individual sessions as an Enneagram consultant and spiritual companion.



The Gifts & Challenges of the Nine Personality Types in the Ministry

How does your personality type affect/shape:

- Your leadership styles & worldviews
- Your Self Care & Spiritual Growth
- Your Ministry of Presence & Pastoral Care

During this four day retreat, facilitator Sandra Smith will weave presentation with self-reflection, silence, dyad inquiry and small group discussion as participants journey to their deeper selves. *The Enneagram Personality System* will serve as a map as we learn the nine distinct personality types, their gifts and challenges as they relate to pastoral leadership. Additionally, we'll consider the barriers to the deeper self, what living on "automatic" looks like, the connection between personality and spirituality and some spiritual strategies for the nine personality types. The entry point into spiritual experience is different for each personality type and involves the conversion from vice to virtue, allowing us to move from judgment to curiosity. Guided meditation will allow time for self-observation and small group discussions will offer strategies for waking up to our lives, for living life more fully and awake. From this place of wakefulness we will ponder the question asked by the Desert Fathers: What is your greatest obstacle to your deepest prayer?

Those new to the Enneagram are encouraged to read *The Essential Enneagram* by David Daniels, MD and Virginia Price before attending the retreat. Participants will gain more from this retreat if they have some knowledge of the Enneagram.
