The Enneagram Personality Assessment Training is designed for professionals such as Pastors, Therapists, Spiritual Directors, and Coaches who have a basic knowledge of the Enneagram and who work with people in a variety of settings to deepen self-awareness. Because the Enneagram system isn't about behavior, but what drives our behavior, an Enneagram typing assessment is always a mutual endeavor. We cannot tell another her/his type, but we can journey with and guide others in their own self-exploration and discernment.

Outcome

Through engaging this process, participants will

- learn the nuances and complexities of each of the nine Enneagram types
 - understand some of the non verbal cues related to the types
 - create and hone a working script for assessing type with clients
 - develop the capacity to discern between look alike types
- deepen their own awareness of the three centers of intelligence to assist in assessment process

Requirements

- A Nine Panels workshop (with Sandra Smith or another certified Narrative Tradition teacher)
 - One day or two half days of Personality Assessment Training (with trainer Sandra Smith)
 - Internship (two supervised typing assessments with Sandra)

It is recommended that the introductory nine panels workshop be the starting point for this process. The supervised typing assessments with Sandra Smith can be done via zoom or in person and will be no longer than 50 minutes each. Once these requirements have been completed, a certificate of completion will be awarded.

Costs to participants

Cost for the one day of Personality Assessment Training: \$175 for approved CFI participants and CFI spiritual directors and \$350 for all other participants.

Cost per supervised typing session: \$95 (paid directly to Sandra at the time of the session). For CFI participants and CFI spiritual directors, CFI will reimburse one \$95 session if receipts are submitted within 30 days of payment.

Sandra is a Certified Narrative Enneagram teacher and an IEA (International Enneagram Association) Accredited Professional. For over 20 years, Sandra has taught the Enneagram internationally as a tool for personal, professional and spiritual development.

Sandra organized and taught at the East Coast Enneagram Professional Training Program (EPTP) founded by Helen Palmer and David Daniels, MD and serves as a mentor/supervisor for candidates seeking certification in the Enneagram Professional Training Program. She received her MDiv from Candler School of Theology at Emory University and a BS in Business from Wake Forest University. She spent 17 years in the corporate world and 14 years directing a nonprofit. Additionally, she is a trained community mediator.

In 2008 she founded AlchemyWorks, which offers workshops, trainings, staff development and team building. Throughout her career, Sandra has facilitated executive leadership and team development trainings as well as trainings for faith community staffs and nonprofit organizations.

In recent years she has presented at the Spiritual Directors International Conference, the International Enneagram Association Conference and the Toronto Enneagram Conference. She has been active in creating new forms of learning with the Enneagram system and weaves her theological education with the Enneagram to offer individual spiritual direction.

In the Spring of 2018, she and an Enneagram colleague created a podcast, Heart of the Enneagram, and explored dimensions of the nine unique personalities by way of interviewing guests of all nine types. Since releasing, the podcast has over 350,000 downloads in 80 countries.



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
